

#### **Music Notes**

Both the **prelude and postlude** this morning are by the North German composer Dietrich Buxtehude. Born in what is now Denmark, Buxtehude spent most of his working life as organist at the Marienkirche in Lubeck. He was very famous as an organist and composer. Such was his fame that the young Bach walked the huge distance to Lubeck to hear Buxtehude play.

**During communion** you will hear the Pie Jesu (Blessed Lord Jesus, give us peace.) from Faure's Requiem. **The Requiem** is Faure's most popular and most commonly performed work, and justly so; it is a beautiful work. It is a pity that more of his works are not performed mor often, as there are many other beautiful works
